GENERAL RULES

Judging Thursday @ 9:00 a.m.

1. All llamas must have up-to-date shots.
2. All llamas must be in designated pens on Monday, July 9th by noon. Please check in with a Superintendent.
3. All llamas will be released from the fair on Sunday, July 15th at 6:00 a.m.
4. Llamas need not to be owned by exhibitors to be exhibited.
5. Llamas are to be exercised only by the exhibitor or a member of their immediate family.
6. Animals are to be worked/exercised only in show area. Llamas are not to be anywhere else on the fairgrounds except by special permission of superintendent.
7. Llama pens are to be kept neat and clean of manure.
8. Brushing and blowing is to be done in designated areas only.
9. Aisles in the barn are to be kept neat and clean.
10. The barn duty roster will be posted during fair.
11. Showmanship contestants are to wear white blouses with black pants or skirts.
12. There will be a manure disposal fee of \$3 per llama. Fees are due on May 1st. Each clubs total pen fees must accompany their pen reservations.
13. Livestock exhibitors must be in compliance with animal health requirements as defined by the department. Please refer to the www.michigan.gov/mdafairreqs. To check these requirements.
